Satya's enterprise, Shri Shakti Alternative Energy Ltd, formed after returning from LSE, was incubated under the PVMTI (Photovoltaic Market Transformation Initiative) program of IFC, Washington, in 2000. PVMTI was funded by Global Environment Facility with World Bank as the Implementation Agency. Shri Shakti Alternative Energy Ltd is the promoter of the first private solar park in Rajasthan of 100MW capacity which is now being expanded to 500MW.

A Champion of Solar in India, Satya firmly believes that India can do several hundred GWs of Solar by 2050. Satya fully supports Mr PiyushGoyal's idea of killing 10 birds with one stone which is the 100GW target by 2022.
