# Background

---

The Indian Nursing Council (INC) initiated the live register in the state of Tamil Nadu. The primary objective of the project is to conduct nurses census i.e., to collect the data regarding number of working nurses i.e, as defined by INC.

Nurse is a person who has completed prescribed course in Nursing from an institution recognized by Indian Nursing Council and registered herself/himself under the State Nursing Council as Nurse and Midwife.

INC decided to conduct the pilot study in the Sivaganga District of Tamil Nadu.

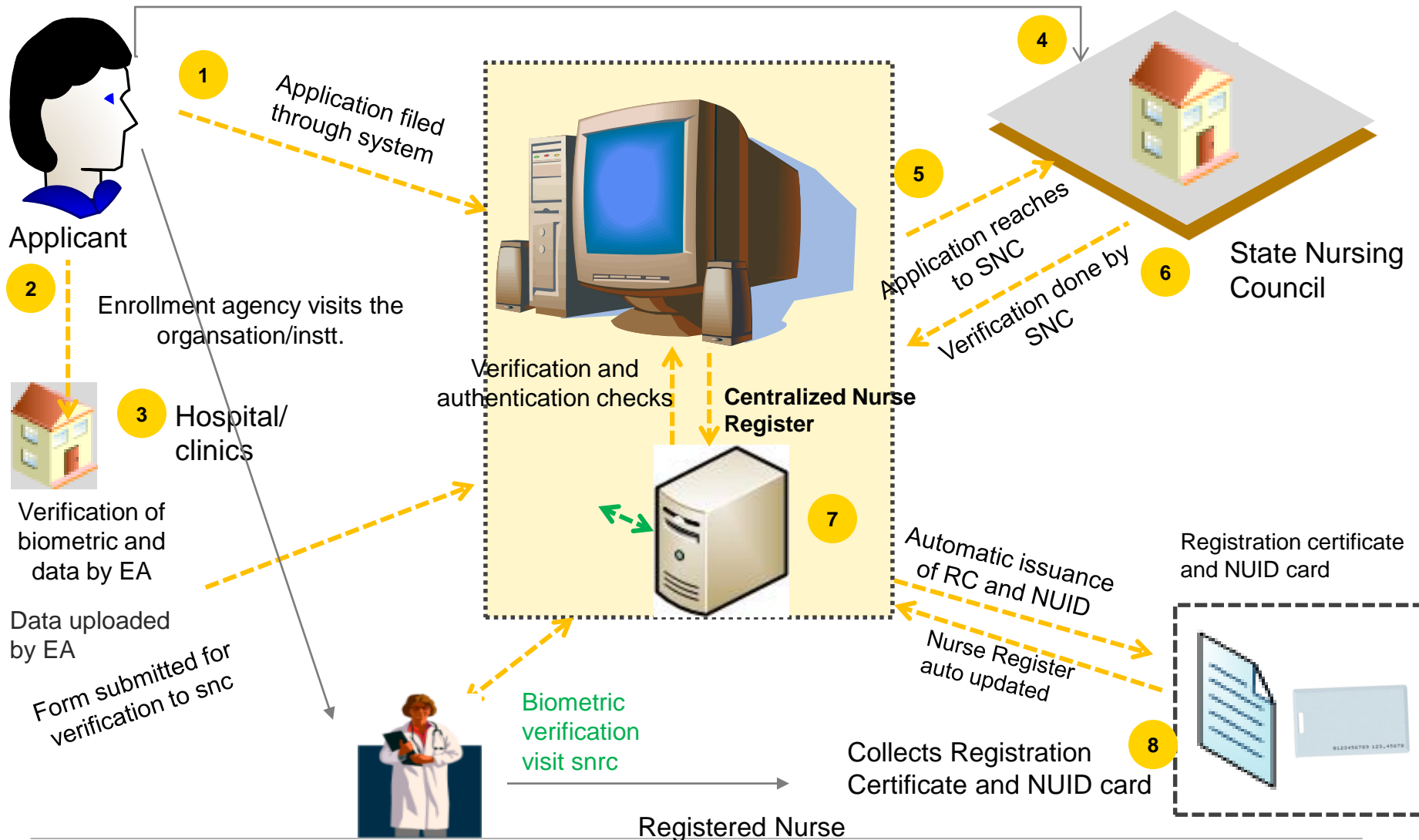

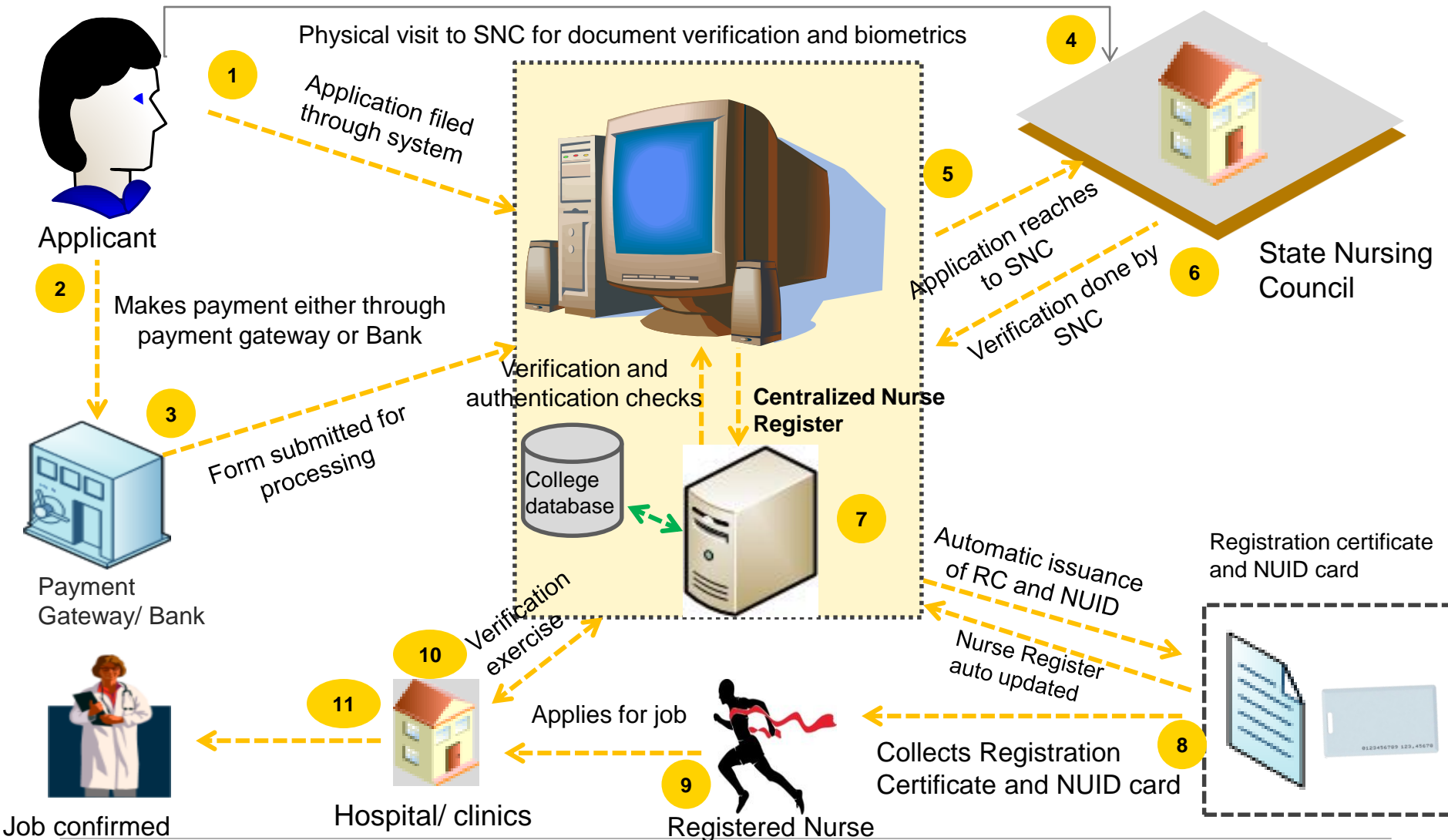

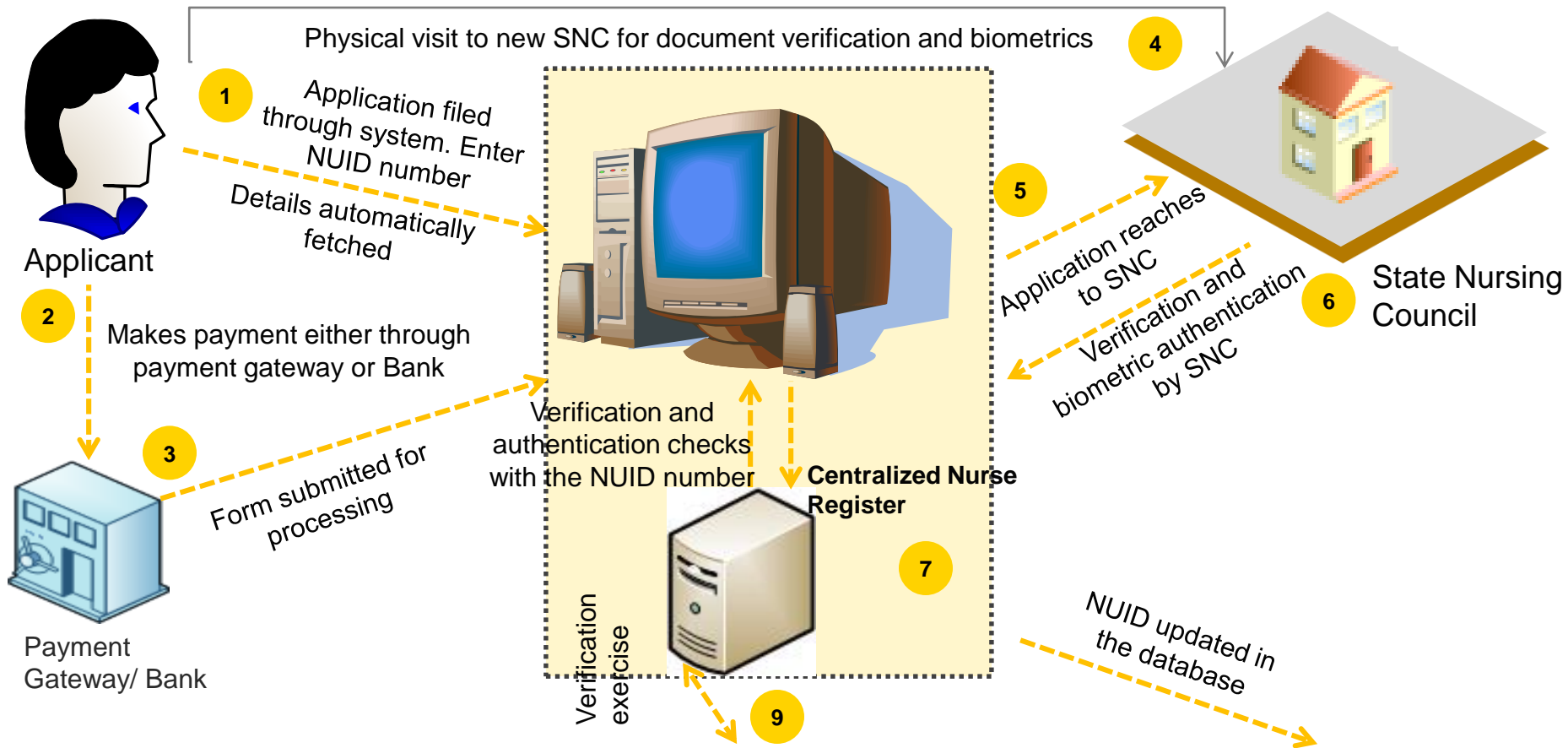
## Primary Registration





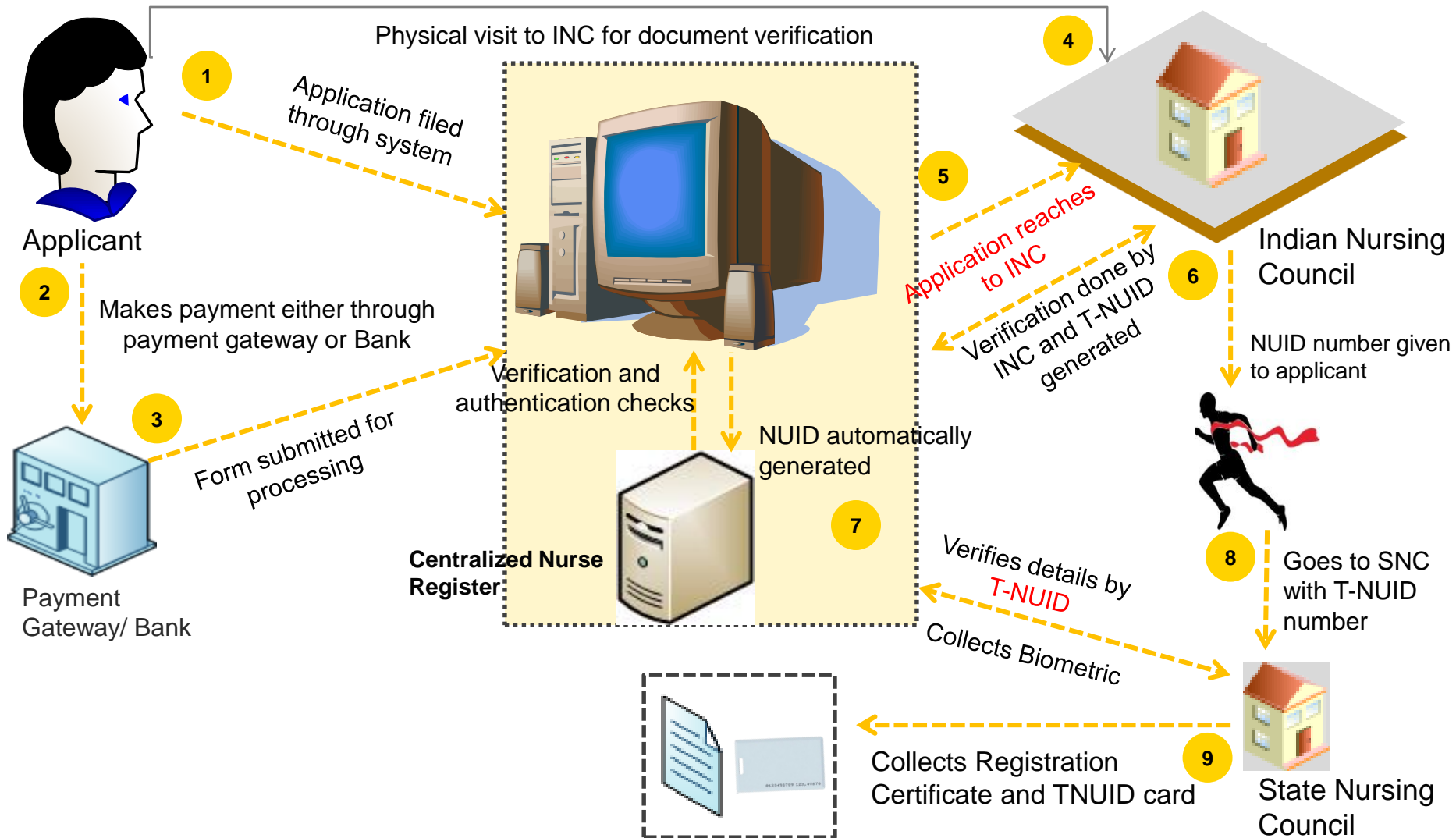
# Envisaged Process Flow

## Reciprocal Registration



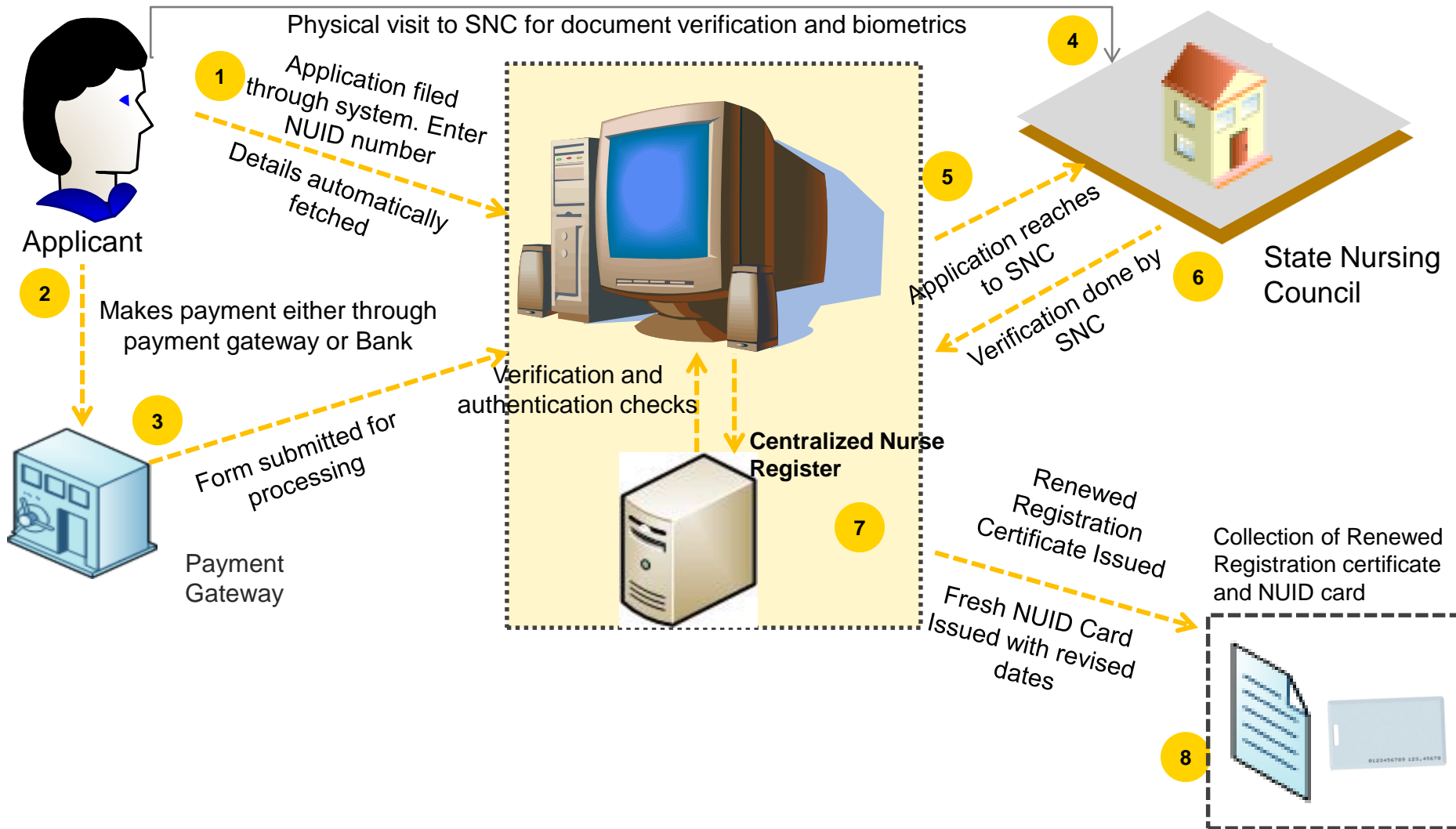
# Envisaged Process Flow

## Temporary Registration



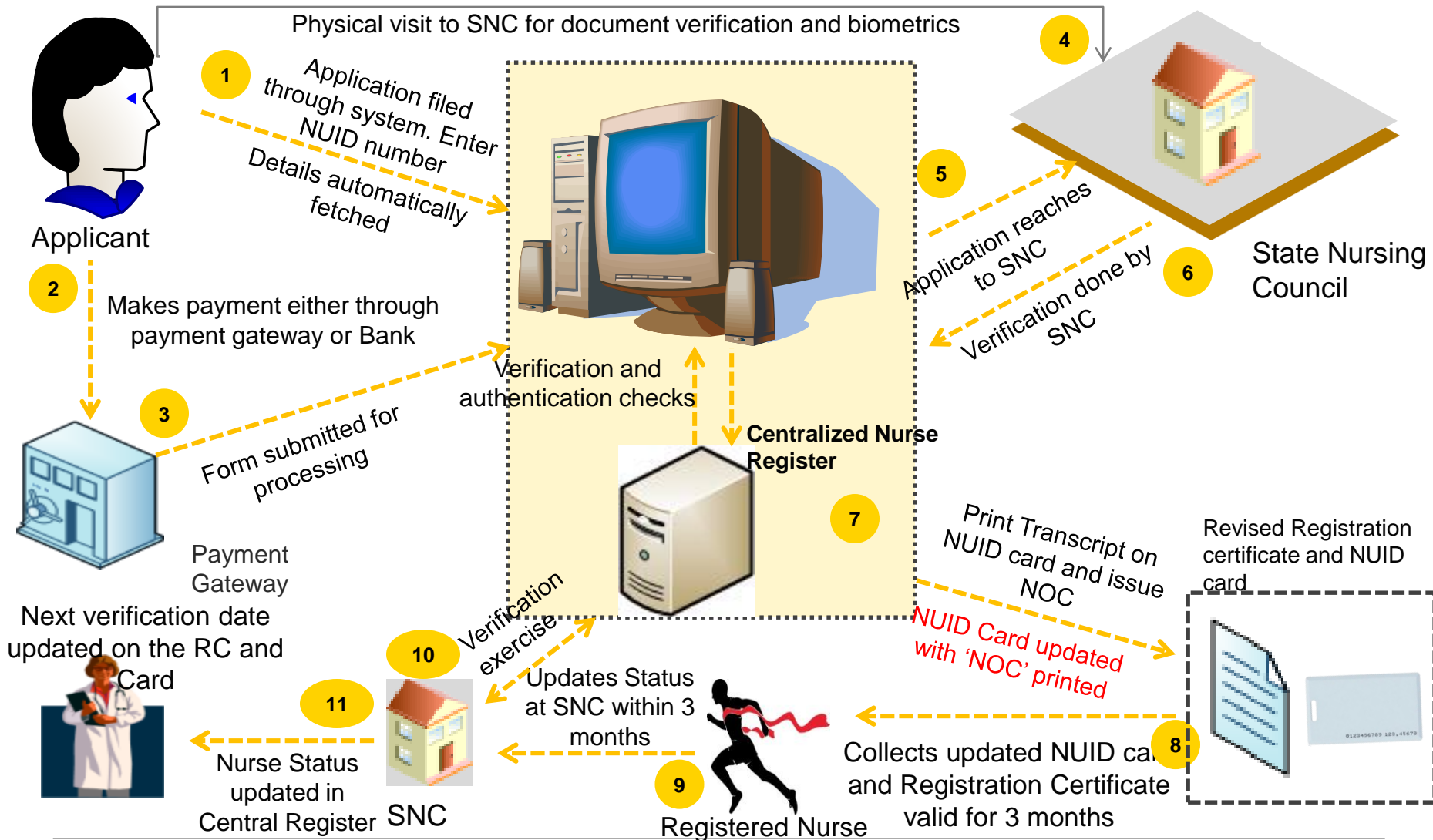
# Envisaged Process Flow

## Renewal of Registration



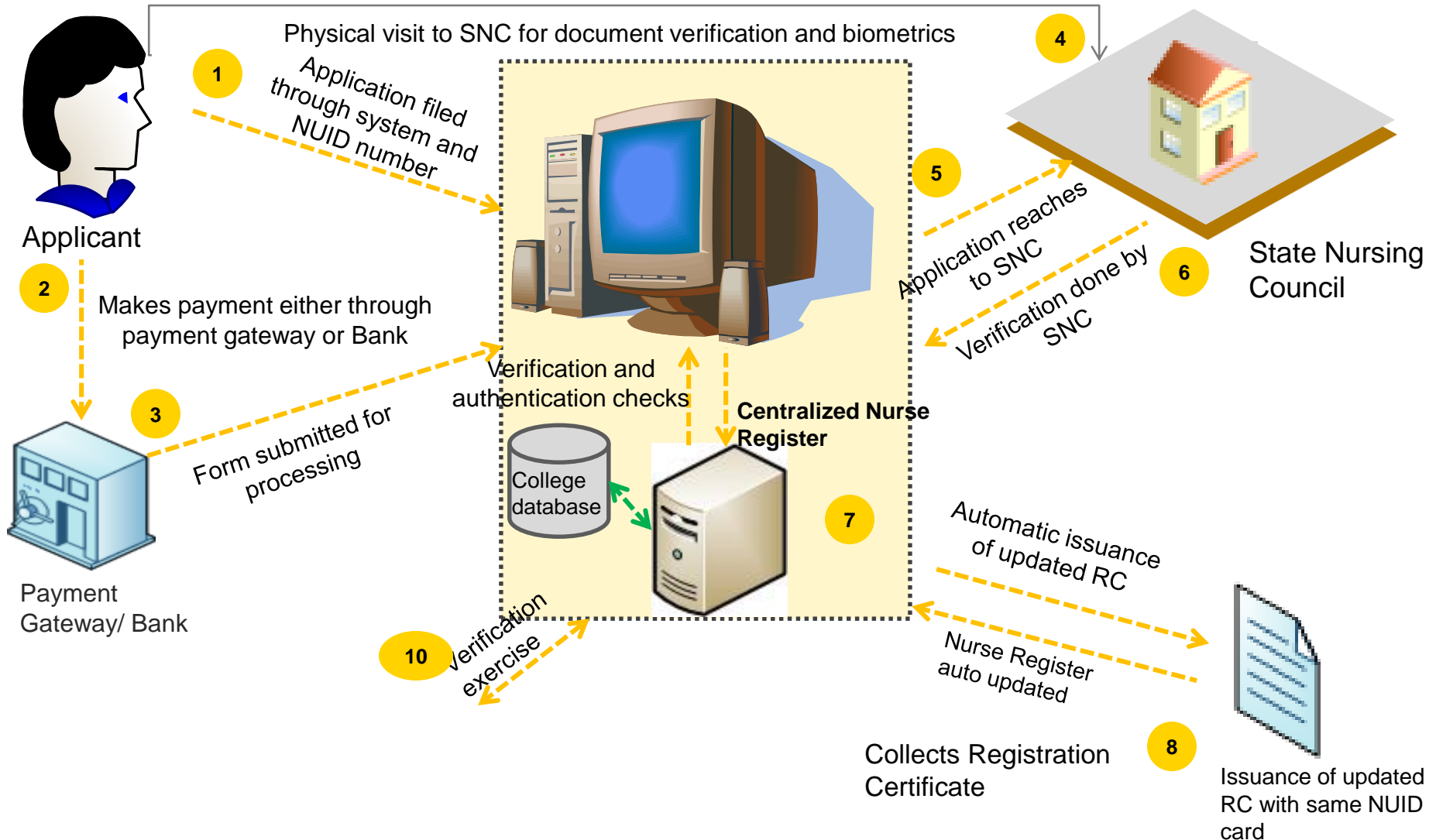

# OBJECTIVES

---

- ▶ Unique identification of each nurse/ midwives resulting in ease of verification process across country
- ▶ Online availability of data of active and registered nurses/ midwives across country through a Computerized Live Register;
- ▶ Online filling and submission of registration application forms;
- ▶ Aadhaar enabled biometric verification
- ▶ Non-duplication of nurses/ midwives data;

- Quick verification process by the hospitals/ private clinics before employing any nurse/midwife through website
  - latest detail of the candidate will be available with photograph
  - Standard application form and procedures for clearances of application forms across the country
  - Primary and Reciprocal registration will be done in a day
  - Digitally signed certificates
  - No more Fake Registration

- Appropriate MIS reporting framework like :
    - at any given time how many nurses are working in each state/district/tehsil category-wise
    - Students admission data base program-wise
    - How many candidates qualified, program-wise, speciality-wise and year-wise
    - Number of Indian nurses migrating to other countries
    - Number of foreign students studying in India
    - Data available to all the stakeholders

  10. Associations are requested to launch a vigorous campaign among Nursing Fraternity about this project and to participate in the Enrolment Drive launched by INC. This campaign in their regular meeting and through the Newsletter.

## Way Forward

---

5. INC has finalized the agency for enrolment through a competitive bidding process. The agency is M/s FINO Paytech for entire India.
6. In the first instance INC is planning to start the enrolment process on pilot basis in the five districts, one from each zone i.e East , North , North East, South and West.
7. The pilot phase is likely to begin in the Month of February 2017 and end by Month of April 2017.
8. During the month of April 2017 the final roll out of the enrolment expected to begin in all the states.
